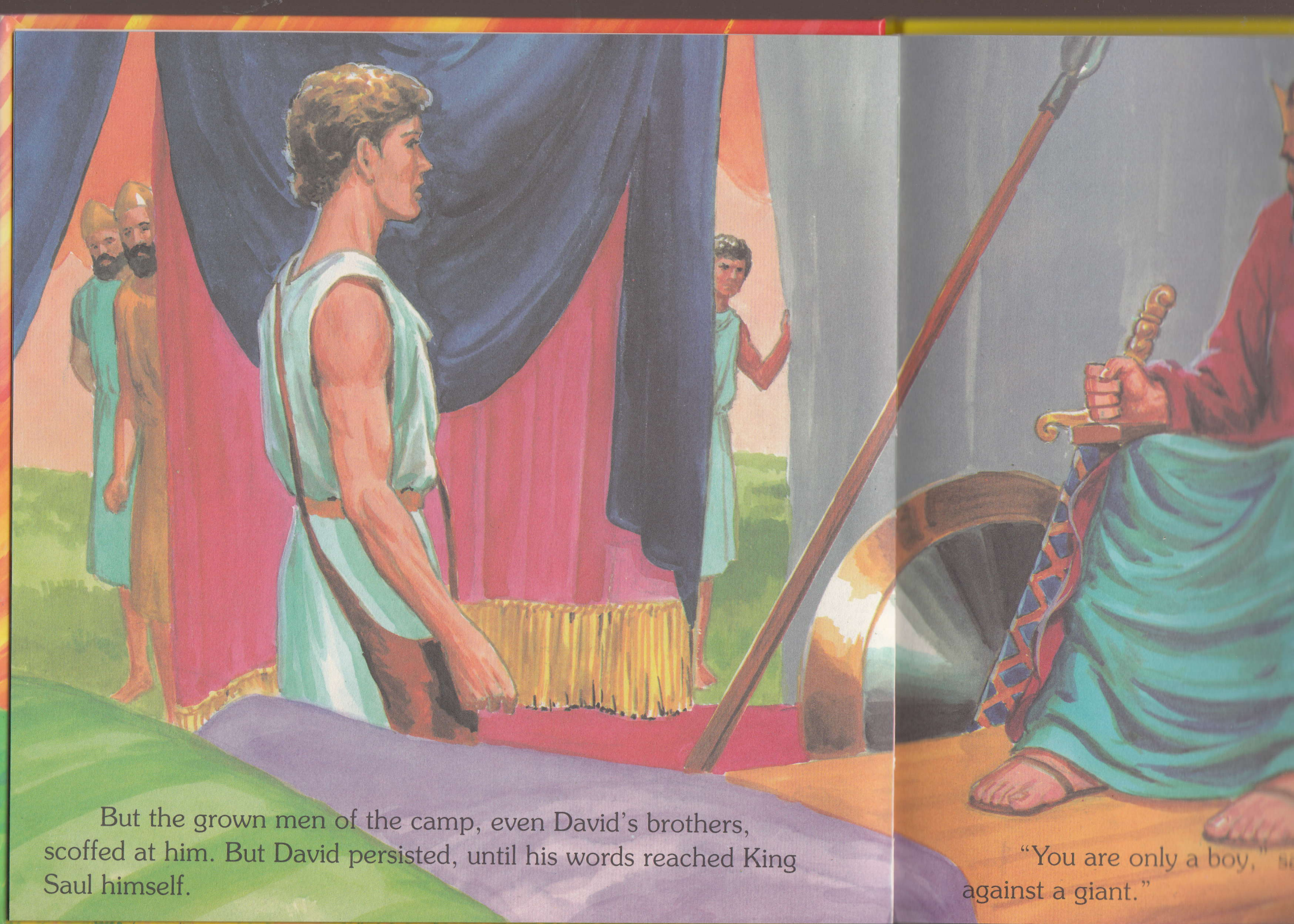
“Who is this Philistine who has defied the army of the Lord?” boy David asked. “I will fight him.”

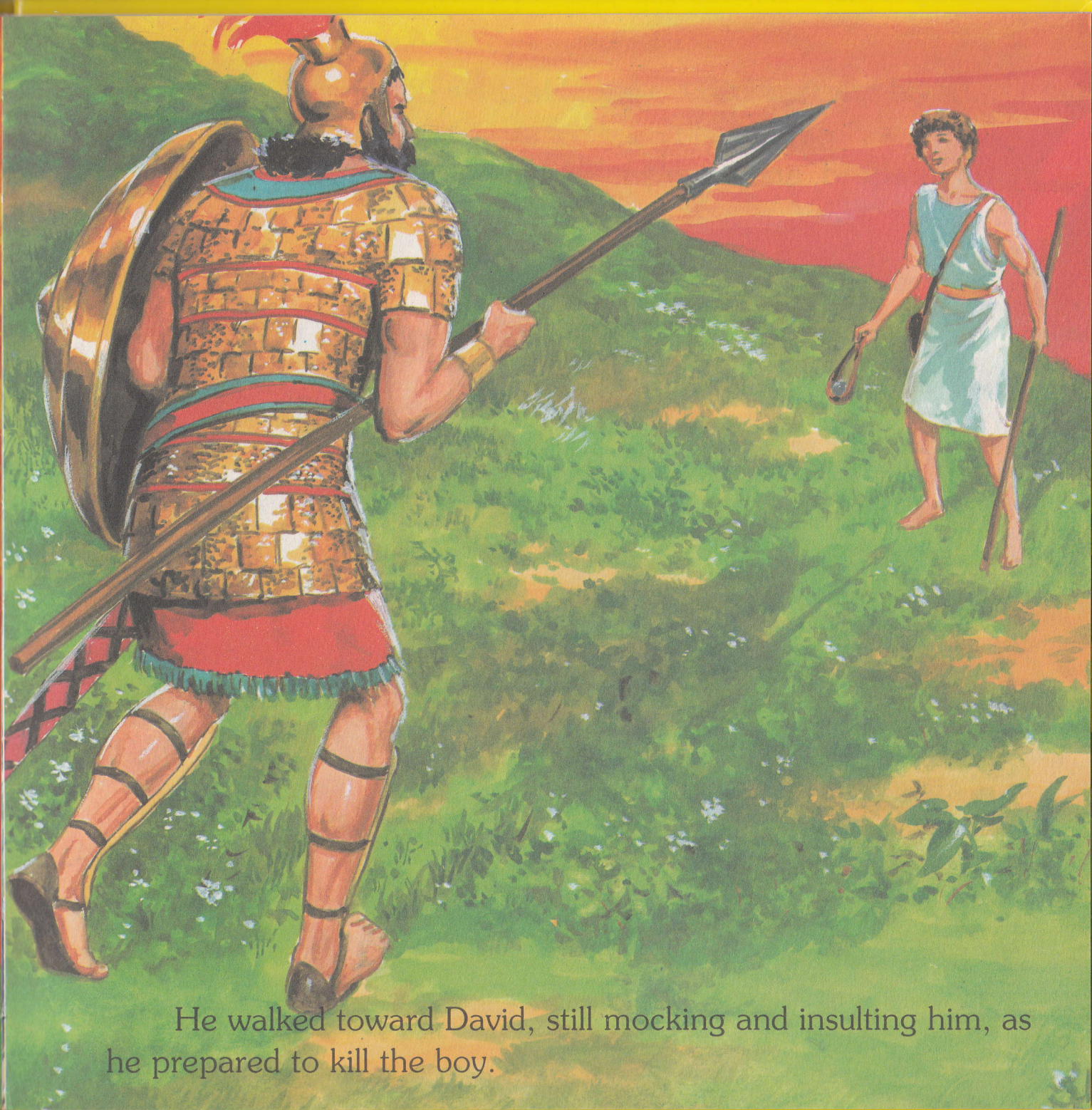
The giant shook with laughter when he saw David.
