## Letters: Capital and Small SUGGESTIONS

**You may wish to use these additional suggestions:**

### Reviewing Letters:

Label a small basket with the words "Letters Basket." Each time children learn a capital and small letter, print the letters on slips of paper and place them in the basket. Review the letters from time to time by having children take slips of paper from the basket and name the letters on them.

Give children clay or modeling dough and demonstrate how to roll the material into long "cords." Then work with children to form capital and small letters with the cords. Have children name each letter they make.

Prepare alphabet soup for children. As children enjoy the soup, invite them to identify the letters in each spoonful they eat.

## **SUGGESTIONS CONTINUED**

### **Matching Capital Letters and Small Letters:**

Write a capital letter inside each section of an egg carton. Provide children with slips of paper that have matching small letters on them. Have children place each small letter in the appropriate section of the egg carton. When children are familiar with all the letters, you may wish to use more than one egg carton so that all the letters of the alphabet can be matched.

On index cards write individual capital and small letters. Make sure there is a matching small letter for each capital letter. Place the cards face down on a table. Have two players take turns turning over two cards each, trying to match a capital letter with a small letter. Each time letters are matched, the player keeps the cards. If letters are not matched, the two cards should be placed face down again. Continue the game until all letters have been matched.

### **Recognizing Letters in Other Surroundings:**

The grocery store is a great place to look for letters! Take a trip to the store with children. As you move down the aisles, challenge children to look for specific letters on signs and food containers. You might also write individual letters on index cards and have children match the letter on each card to a letter in the store.

Play a letter game while traveling with children. Starting with the letter A, ask children to find individual letters of the alphabet on road signs or license plates.

### **Extending the Pages of the Book:**

After completing each page of this book, work with children to tell a short story about the Beginners Bible™ characters on the page.

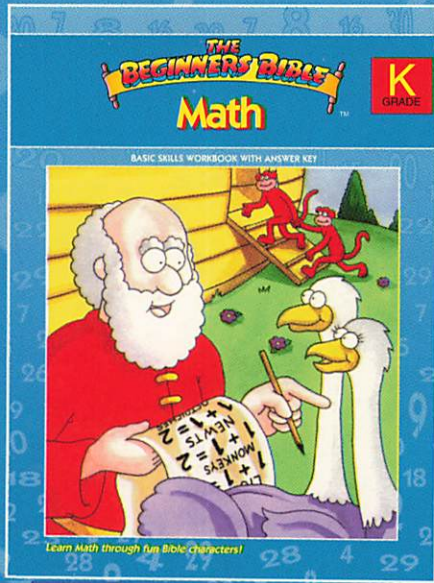

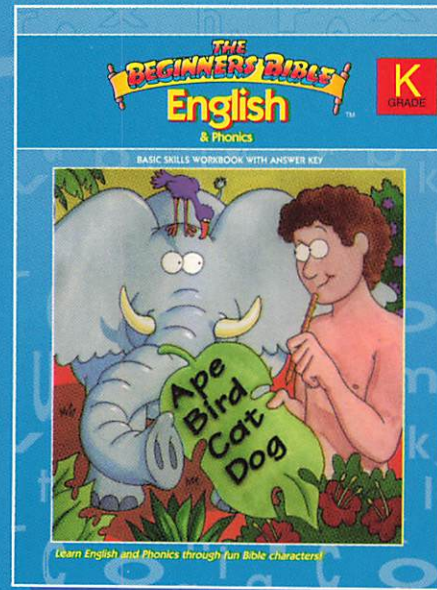

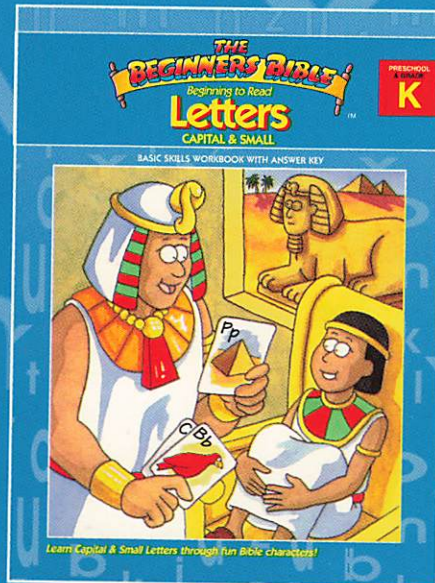
