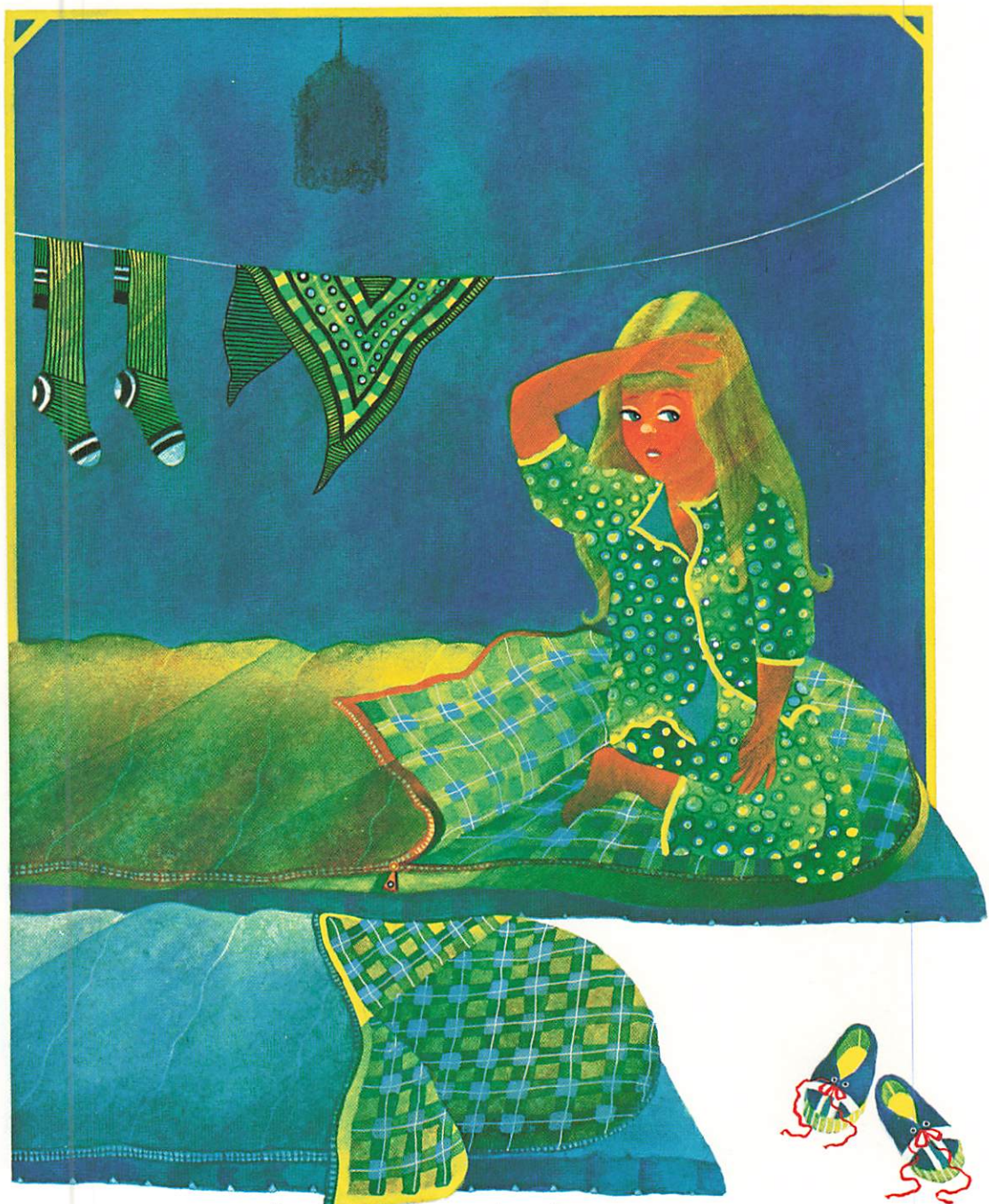
Roll out the beds.  
Turn out the light.



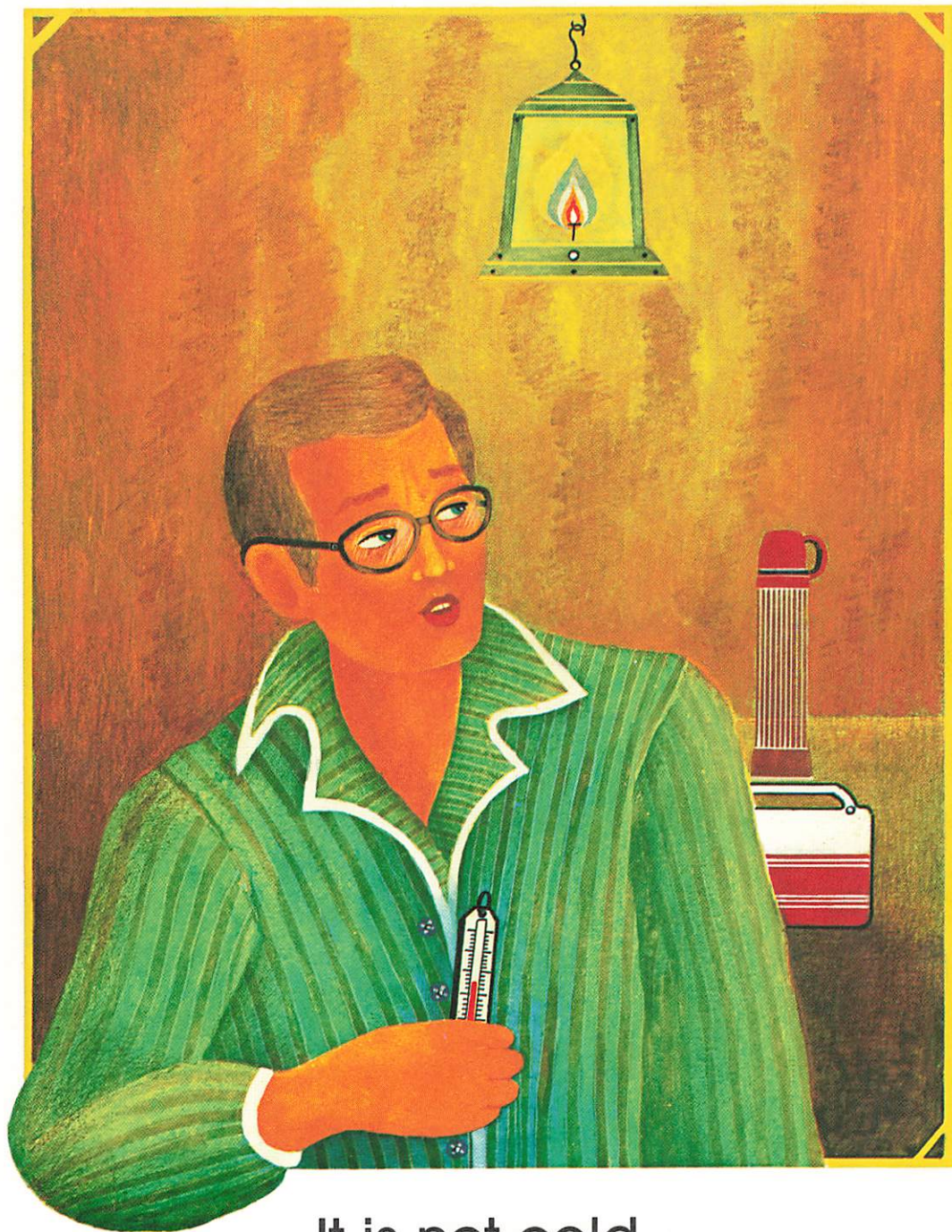
It is time to sleep.  
Say good night.



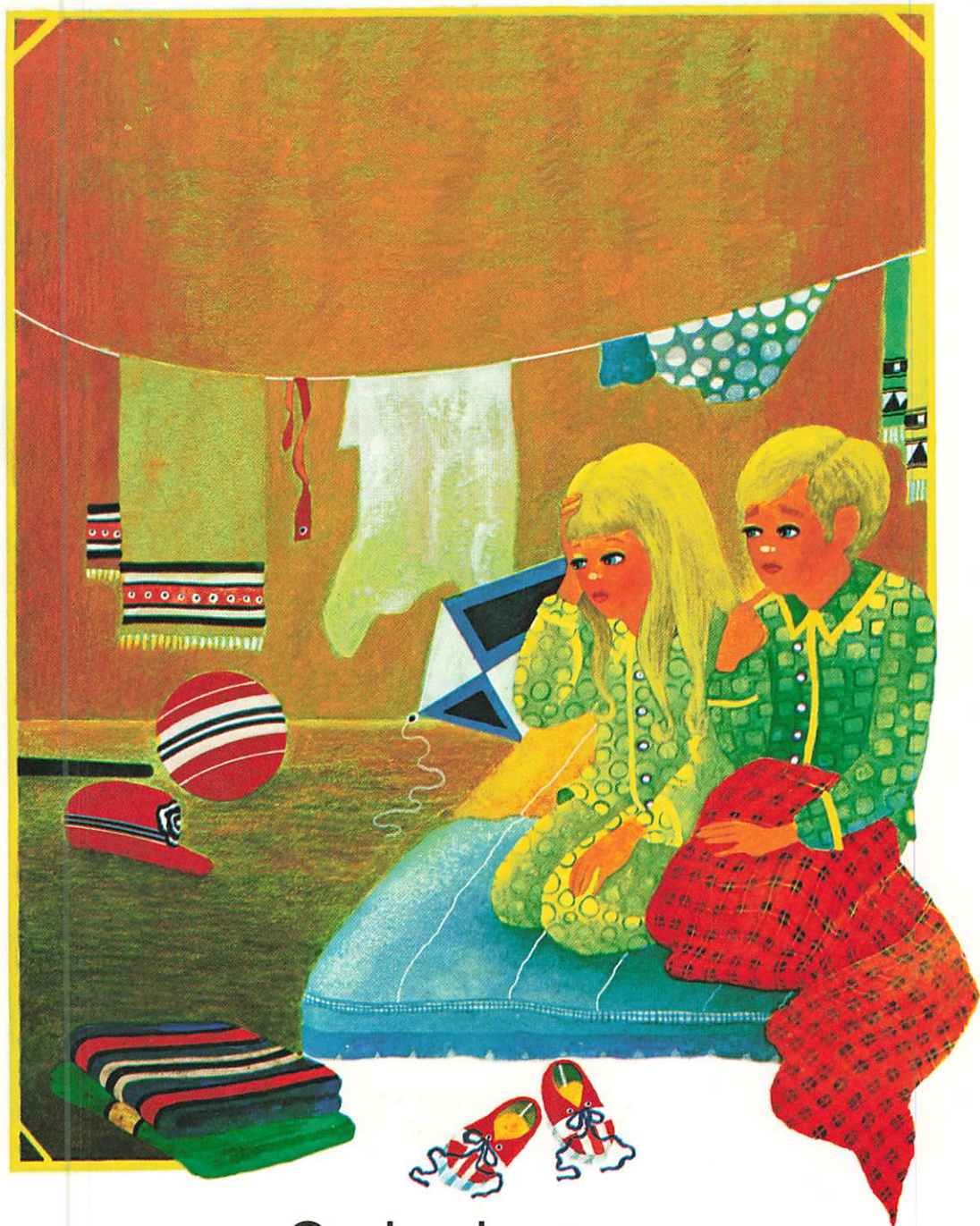
I can not sleep.  
The night is cold.



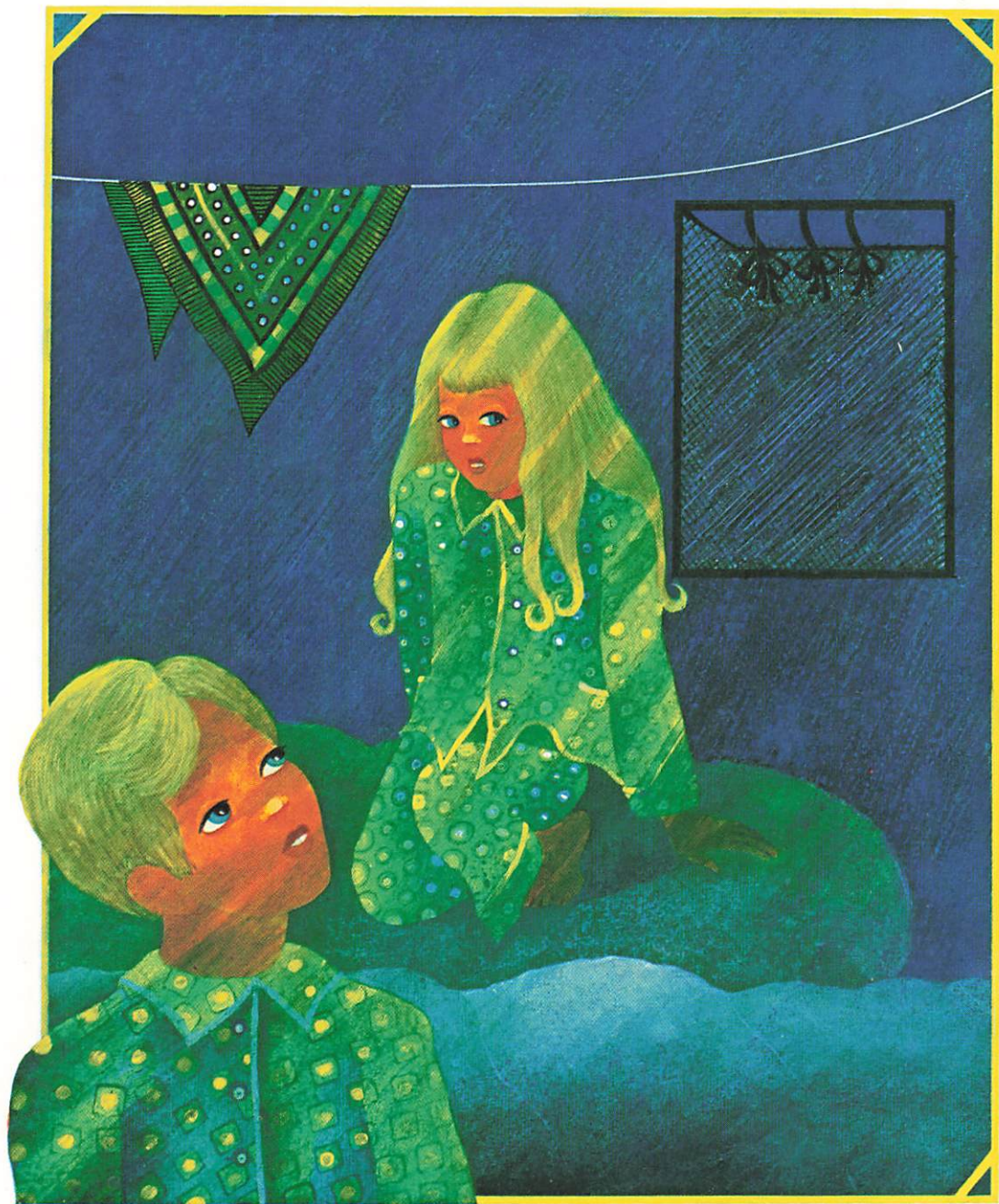
I can not sleep.  
The night is hot.



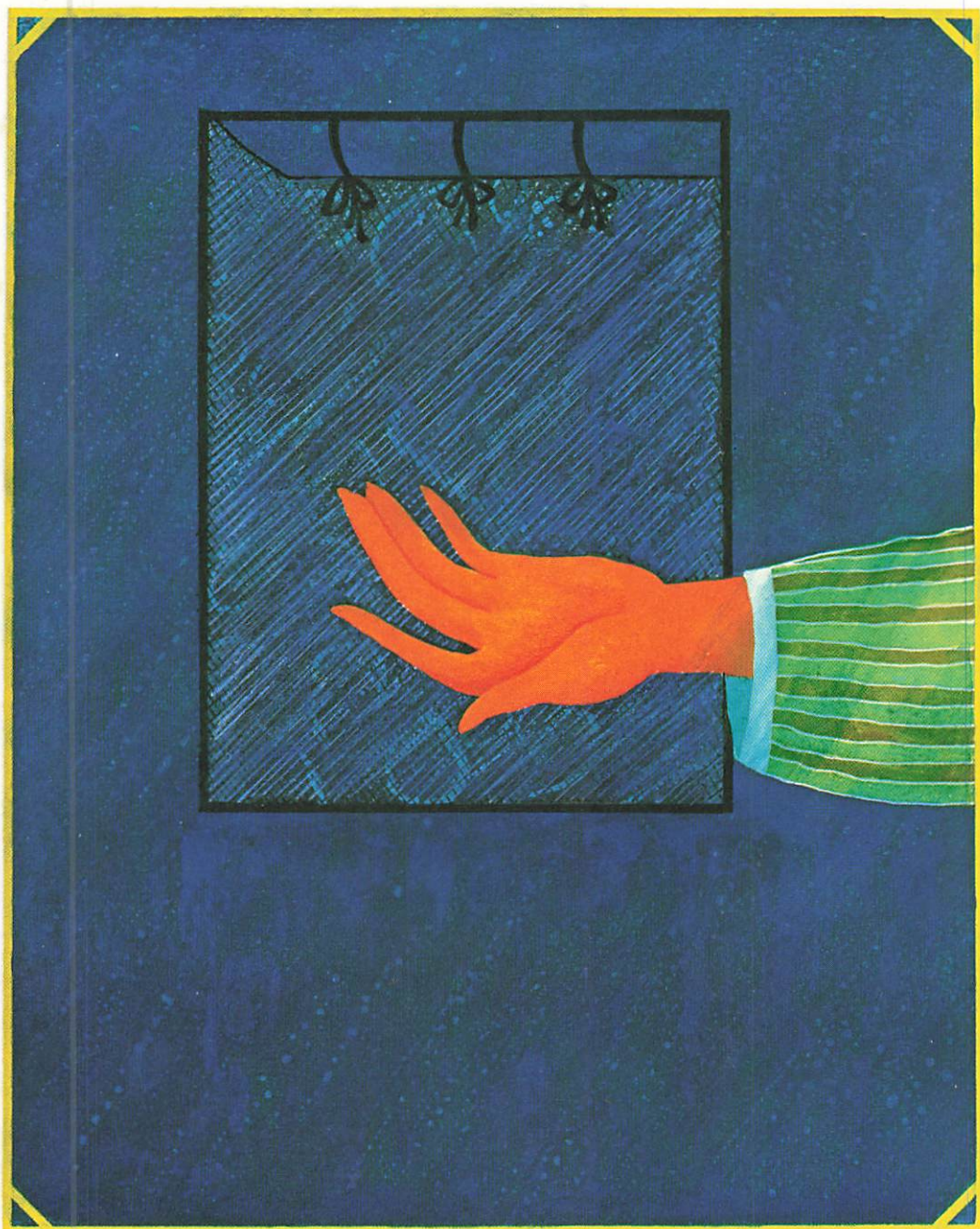
It is not cold.  
It is not hot.



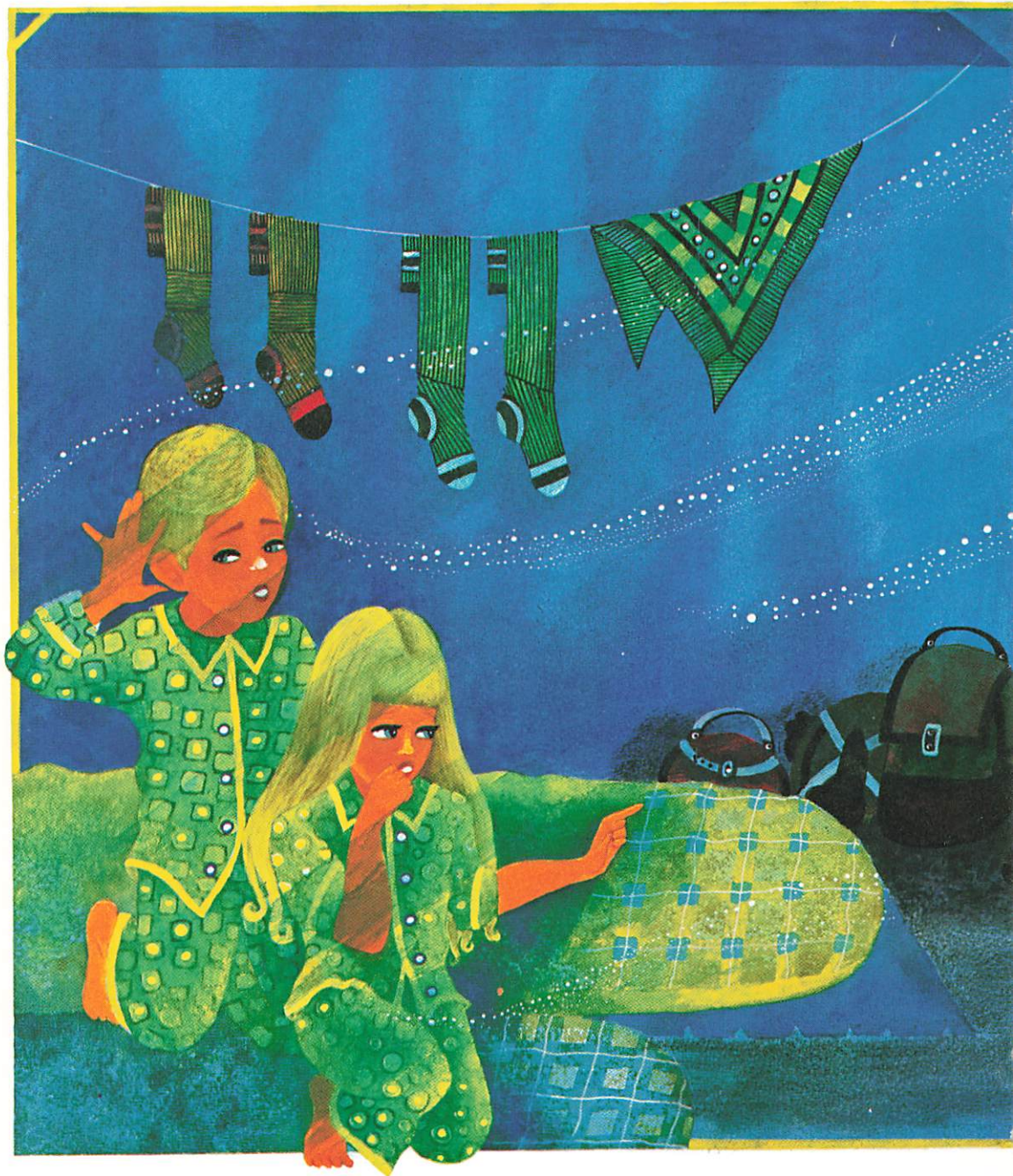
Go to sleep.

I see a wolf!



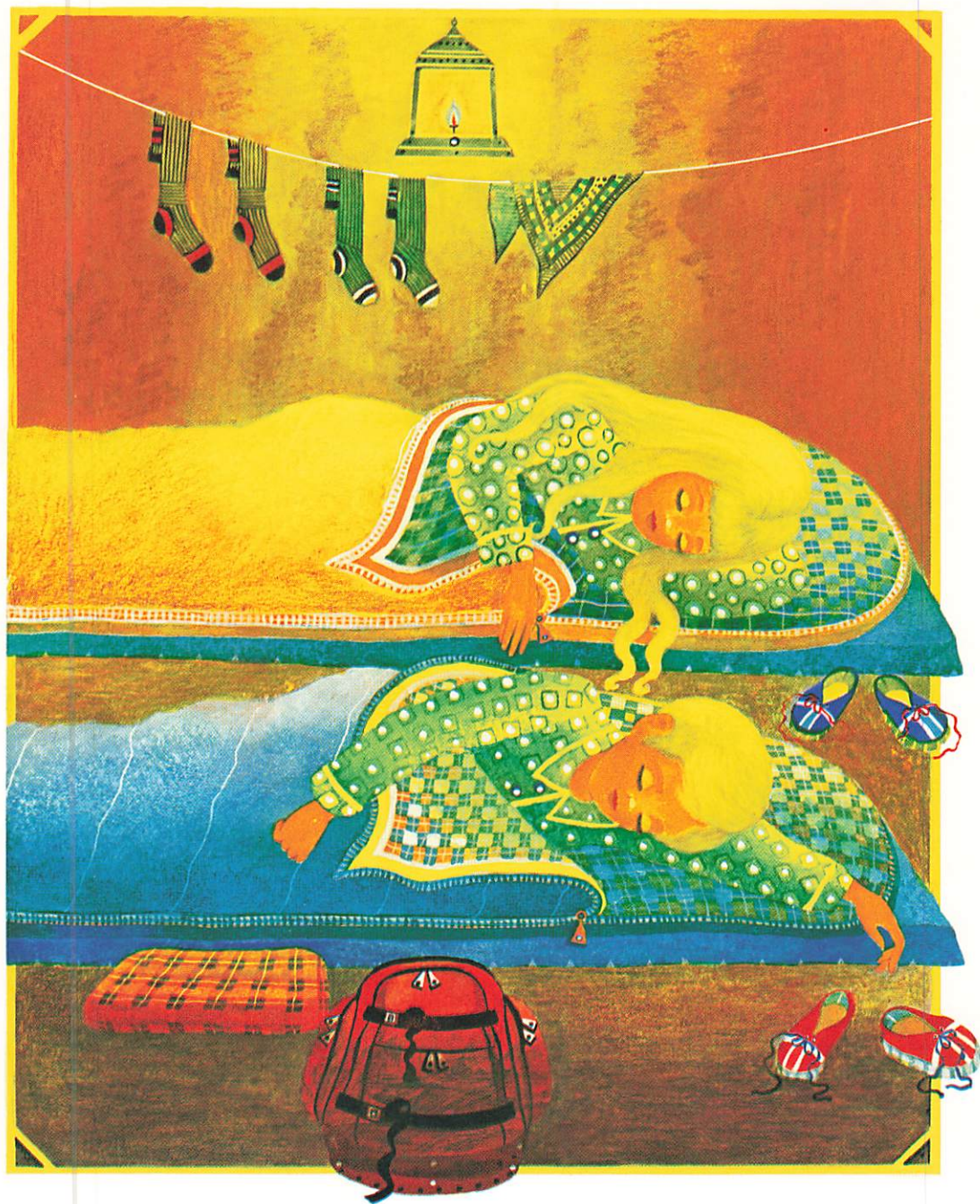
There is no bear.

## PARENT GUIDE

---

By the time children are ready to begin reading, they have learned about books, pictures, and words. They know that words can be put together in sentences to tell a story. Much of beginning reading is memorization of the words and short sentences used in a story. So in order to read successfully, children must:

**master a basic sight vocabulary,**

**learn to decode words phonetically (pronounce words by sounding out the letters or syllables),**

**learn to use context and picture clues.**

The School Zone START TO READ series helps children learn to read by presenting interesting stories with an easy vocabulary based mainly on words that can be recognized on sight. Words are repeated. Sentences are short. Rhyming words are used to help children increase vocabulary. Clues are abundant in the pictures. After several readings with the parent, the child should be able to read alone. If the child can't, it's better not to pressure. The child *has* experienced a pleasant story.

Before reading stories in the School Zone START TO READ series, children can learn a sight vocabulary with School Zone's BASIC VOCABULARY FLASH CARDS. They can *get ready* with the language books in the School Zone PRESCHOOL series. To advance reading ability, children in grades 1-3 can practice with the reading and phonics workbooks in School Zone's I KNOW IT! series.

The vocabulary words in SAY GOOD NIGHT are mainly first-grade words. The words **roll, turn, hot, lot, listen, tent, dry, wolf,** and **wind** are second-grade words. You should help your child sound out these words.
